ANTI-RAGGING COMMITTEE

College/ University campus is a place to find valuable friendship and to cherish unforgettable moments. We, here at SRM strongly condemn any kind of ragging practices. We do not believe in violence or unhealthy practices. Our faculty members impart good values with education and that is what sets SRM apart.

What constitutes Ragging?

Ragging constitutes one or more of any of the following acts:

- Any conduct by any student or students whether by words spoken or written or by an act which has the effect of teasing, treating or handling with rudeness a fresher or any other student;
- Indulging in rowdy or indiscipline activities by any student or students which
 causes or is likely to cause annoyance, hardship, physical or psychological
 harm or to raise fear or apprehension thereof in any fresher or any other
 student:
- Asking any student to do any such act which he/she would not do in the ordinary
 course and which has the effect of causing or generating a sense of shame, or
 torment or embarrassment so as to adversely affect the physique or psyche of
 such fresher or any other student;
- Any act by a senior student that prevents, disrupts or disturbs the regular academic activity of any other student or a fresher;
- Exploiting the services of a fresher or any other student for completing the academic tasks assigned to an individual or a group of students.
- Any act of financial extortion or forceful expenditure burden put on a fresher or any other student by students;
- Any act of physical abuse including all variants of it: sexual abuse, homosexual assaults, stripping, forcing obscene and lewd acts, gestures, causing bodily harm or any other danger to health or person;
- Any act or abuse by spoken words, emails, post, public insults which would also
 include deriving perverted pleasure, vicarious or sadistic thrill from actively or
 passively participating in the discomfiture to fresher or any other student;
- Any act that affects the mental health and self-confidence of a fresher or any other student with or without an intent to derive a sadistic pleasure or showing off power, authority or superiority by a student over any fresher or any other student.

Actions Suggested by UGC / AICTE against students indulging and abetting in Ragging

- The punishment to be meted out to the persons indulged in ragging has to be exemplary and justifiably harsh to act as a deterrent against recurrence of such incidents. The students who are found to be indulged in ragging should be debarred from taking admission in any technical institution in India.
- 2. Every single incident of ragging a First Information Report (FIR) must be filed without exception by the institutional authorities with the local police authorities.
- Depending upon the nature and gravity of the offence as established by the Anti-Ragging Committee of the institution, the possible punishments for those found guilty of ragging at the institution level shall be any one or any combination of the following.
 - Cancellation of admission
 - Suspension from attending classes
 - Withholding/withdrawing scholarship/fellowship and other benefits
 - Debarring from appearing in any test/examination or other evaluation process
 - Withholding results
 - Debarring from representing the institution in any regional, national or international meet, tournament, youth festival, etc.
 - Suspension/expulsion from the hostel
 - Rustication from the institution for period ranging from 1 to 4 semesters
 - Expulsion from the institution and consequent debarring from admission to any other institution.
 - Fine of Rupees 25,000/-
 - Collective punishment: when the persons committing or abetting the crime of ragging are not identified, the institution shall resort to collective punishment as a deterrent to ensure community pressure on the potential raggers.
- 4. The institutional authority shall intimate the incidents of ragging occurred in their premises along with actions taken to the Council immediately after occurrence of such incident and inform the status of the case from time to time.
- Courts should make an effort to ensure that cases involving ragging are taken up on priority basis to send the correct message that ragging is not only to be discouraged but also to be dealt with sternness.

ATTENDANCE POLICY

- A minimum of <u>75% attendance</u> is required for students to be able to take the end semester examination. Without the minimum attendance of 75%, students become ineligible to write the end semester examination. His / Her registration for that course will be treated as cancelled, and he/she shall be awarded 'W' grade (W stands for registration cancelled for want of minimum attendance) in that course. This grade shall appear in the grade card until the course is successfully completed.
- Attendance between 70% and 75% will be considered on case basis.
- All applications for attendance put up by students must be presented at the end of the semester if required. This means students must keep a copy of all applications with them.
- Leave taken during external examination will be considered as absent and students will have to rewrite their examination in their next semester.
- Mass bunking is a grave offence and exhibits an utter disregard for University rules and norms. Strict disciplinary action will be taken against mass bunking by the Departmental Disciplinary Committee. If more than 90% of the students are missing from the class, it will constitute mass bunking.
- All ODs certified by the concerned faculty will be considered as fully present.
- It is the RESPONSIBILITY of the student to constantly check their attendance averages with the respective subject teachers.

Condonation Policy

If the students have attendance between 65% and 75%, a condonation fees of Rs. 200 per subject will be charged.

Medical Leave Policy

- Attendance equal to and above 60% to 69% will be considered only on valid medical grounds supported by medical certificates or case sheets for hospitalizations. All medical papers must be submitted by students immediately upon joining (maximum 3 days delay after joining class) and **NOT** at the end of the semester.
- All medical reasons will not be entertained. This is subject to approval by the Departmental Leave Approval committee.
- Medical rests prescribed by the doctor should be put up for review by students PRIOR to taking medical rest. If applications are put up POST medical rest all absences will be considered as absent from the class.

- 3. BROWSING IS NOT ALLOWED DURING LAB HOURS. Students are not allowed to misuse the internet facilities.
- 4. Every Student shall conduct himself / herself in such a way to cause no disturbance to the working of the classes or to fellow students.
- 5. RAGGING, CONSUMING ALCOHOL AND SMOKING ARE STRICTLY PROHIBITED IN THE UNIVERSITY CAMPUS.
- 6. No function shall be arranged by the students in the university campus without prior permission from the HOI.
- 7. Writing on walls, pillars, bath rooms and furniture or black boards is strictly prohibited.
- The cost of any damage, if caused to university property will be charged to the accounts of the students responsible for the damage in addition to disciplinary action.
- 9. Students are advised to switch off fans and lights when they leave the class rooms.
- 10. Furniture in the class rooms should not be moved or displaced.
- 11. Students are expected to be appropriately dressed to attend classes or any university function.
- 12. No students shall remain in the hostel during class hours unless he / she is sick and is permitted to be on leave.
- Wearing of University ID card is compulsory within the campus and on all the occasions.
- 14. Students have to compulsorily wear the university uniform on the specified days (Monday, Wednesday and Friday) and whenever they are representing the university or attending university functions.



- There are two types of activities: Regular Activities (120 hours) and Annual Special Camp (120 hours). All the NSS Volunteers who have served NSS for at list 2 years and have performed 240 hours of work under NSS are entitled to a certificate from the university under the signature of the Vice-Chancellor and the Programme Coordinator. The Annual camps are known as Special Camps. Camps are held annually, funded by the government of India, and are usually located in a rural village or a city suburb. Volunteers may be involved in such activities as:

UNIVERSITY TRANSPORT FACILITY

The need for safe passage of each student to college and back home is of paramount importance to us. To ensure safe travel the college has its own fleet of outsourced college buses designed as per standards and manned by trained drivers and personnel sensitized to the needs of student. The Transport Service (optional) is operated by the college and a separate transport fee is charged for the same. For supervision and monitoring a transport attendant is on board throughout the journey. Divisions and batches are allotted as per the transport requisitions put forth by the students as transport service is not available for a few batches. If there is any query related to transportation, kindly contact transport Coordinator in 9641590009 before finalizing with the admission process.

Rules Governing Transport Facility

- Transport service is an optional service facilitated and outsourced by the College for the convenience of its students.
- The College bus facility available to the student cannot be expected or demanded as a matter of right. The Transport Department at their own discretion has the right to disallow any student from availing the bus facility.
- Students availing the bus facility will be provided with a bus ID card. Generally, the bus timings will operate within 10 to 15 minutes of the pickup and alighting time. Parents are requested to accommodate the same.
- Any change in the bus timings will be notified to the parent by the Transport Department.
- Students will have to board and alight the school bus at the respective stops allotted to them only. The Transport Department reserves the rights to allot the stops.

Students while traveling on the school bus must maintain discipline. Any student

suilty of misconduct will not be allowed to evail the bus facility.

guilty of misconduct will not be allowed to avail the bus facility.

A student shall be refused the bus facility if involved in damage to the bus

property. Besides, the damage done will have to be compensated by the

student.

Discontinuation of bus facility will only be allowed term wise. Bus facility

cannot be discontinued for any particular month.

No transport facility shall be available for other activities / events that school

may plan on holidays / vacations.

Students/ parents will not have any transactions / altercation / physical fight

with the bus staff. Bus employees are not authorized to change/add bus

stops.

The school has taken utmost care for the safety and convenience of the

students.

Any suggestion/ complaint regarding the transport service is to be made in

writing strictly to the Transport Department and the same shall be entertained

by the Transport Department only.

It is important that any change to the usual pick-up/ drop routine is intimated

to the transport in charge a day in advance.

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COVID-19 STANDARD OPERATING PROCEDURES

Standard Operating Procedure for the students to adhere inside the University Campus and Hostel:

Consent form:

- It is mandatory to get consent for attending the classes through offline mode (on
 - campus) by the students from their parents or guardian and submit it to the
 respective class teachers.
- It's important to report any travel history by the students prior to joining the university for the offline class.
- It is understood that the student must be free of any symptoms like fever, cold, cough, etc.
- It is discouraged that no student from any containment zone or any family member tested positive for COVID to attend the offline classes.

Preparation:

- It is mandatory to wear a mask during travelling and the entire time the students are present at the university.
- It is mandatory to have a personal hand sanitizer for the students to sanitize their hands often.
- 3. Clean drinking water facility will be available in the campus, however, students are advised to carry a water bottle to avoid unnecessary sharing of water.
- 4. It is advised to carry their own packed food (snacks/lunch) from home and going to nearby restaurants is strongly discouraged.
- Sneezing, coughing should be done with covered mouth with a help of flexed elbow.
- 6. It is advised to have tissue papers for easy disposal after sneezing, coughing.
- 7. it is advised to download "Aarogya Setu" application on the student's smartphones for self-assessment often.

At the Entrance:

- Students should be aware that a separate entry and exit doors will be functional at the university premise and they are instructed to follow the same.
- 2. Before entering into the university, it is mandatory to follow a queue with 6 feet of physical distancing.
- 3. It is mandatory to check the body temperature using a handheld thermal-gun, as a screening measure in the guard post before entering into the university.

- 4. The hand sanitizer will be sprayed on the student's hands and it should be rubbed completely on the hands.
- 5. After entering into the university building students should get into their respective classrooms immediately.
- Crowding of walkway path, passages or veranda of the university is strongly discouraged.
- 7. Any symptoms development should be immediately conveyed to the class teacher.

In the Classrooms:

- 1. Students should sit in their designated seats only.
- 2. Sitting beside or in close distance will not be allowed at any circumstances.
- 3. Physical contact during class activities is strongly discouraged.
- 4. There won't be any exchange of learning materials between teachers and the students and also between the students. The learning materials, if needed, will be given in prior to the students. Respective copy should be brought for the class.
- 5. There won't be any exchange between the students like laptops, face masks, hand gloves, etc.
- 6. Used tissue papers must be disposed off in the designated carton box/bins and should not be thrown into the common dustbins.
- 7. Crowding near the restrooms is prohibited.
- 8. In the event of using restrooms, students have to follow queue and at any given time only 3 students will be allowed to enter the restroom.
- 9. It is mandatory to wash hands using a liquid soap/handwash after using the restroom not less than 30 seconds.
- 10. Once the student enters the University, he/she shall be allowed outside the university only after completion of all the classes.

In the Laboratories:

- The designated batch for practical sessions will be intimated by the class in-charge to the students.
- 2. Entering into the labs will be in an orderly manner with 6 feet of physical distance.
- 3. Before entering the lab, it is mandatory to wear hand gloves before starting the experiment/typing.
- 4. Students should sit/occupy the designated seats/area only. In any circumstances crowding or sitting beside each other will not be allowed.
- After the practical session, the used hand gloves should be removed and disposed in the designated carton box/bins only. It should not be disposed in common dustbins.
- 6. While exiting from the labs students near to the entrance should leave first with 6 feet of physical distancing followed by the next nearer subsequently.

7. After each practical session it is advised to wash your hands using the hand wash or soap for not less than 30 seconds.

Exit from the University:

- Every department will leave the students to go out at different timings to avoid crowding of the exit path.
- Its student's responsibility to know their respective department's exit time from the class teachers.
- 3. It is compulsory for the students to leave the classrooms in an orderly manner with 6 feet of physical distancing between them.
- 4. Once the students got out there should not be crowding or gatherings.
- Students should maintain physical distancing till they exit the University campus and thereafter.

Students Hostel:

Preparation – It is mandatory for the hostel students to undergo a 14 days of quarantine even if you have been tested negative in the recent COVID test.

At Hostel - Entrance:

- Before entering into the hostel, it is mandatory to follow a queue with 6 feet of physical distancing.
- 2. It is mandatory to check the body temperature using a handheld thermal-gun, as a screening measure at the entrance of the hostel.
- 3. After checking for body temperature, the hand sanitizer will be sprayed on the student's hands and it should be rubbed completely on the hands for at least 20 seconds continuously.
- 4. It is advised to wear masks at all the time inside the hostel facility.
- 5. After entering into the hostel, students should get into their respective rooms.
- Crowding of walkway path, passages or veranda of the hostel is strongly discouraged.
- 7. Any symptom development is present the student should be conveyed to the hostel warden immediately.

At Hostel - Common Utility Areas:

- 1. Students will be called in a phase manner for taking their food.
- 2. It is advised to have separate plates and glasses for usage and wash it thoroughly with dish wash liquid after taking the food.
- 3. Taking of food to students' rooms will be encouraged.

- 4. Usage of washing area (wash basin, getting potable water, etc.) will be in queue with 6 feet of physical distancing only.
- 5. It is mandatory for the students to maintain hygiene inside the rooms by adequately using the housekeeping facilities.

At Hostel - Exit:

- 1. Students should exit the hostel for attending the classes at the university should be in an orderly manner with 6 feet of physical distancing.
- 2. Wearing of mask is mandatory during the time of travelling/walking to the University.
- 3. It is strongly discouraged to touch anything unwantedly during the travelling/walking time, if in the event of touching, it is mandatory to use hand sanitizer immediately.
